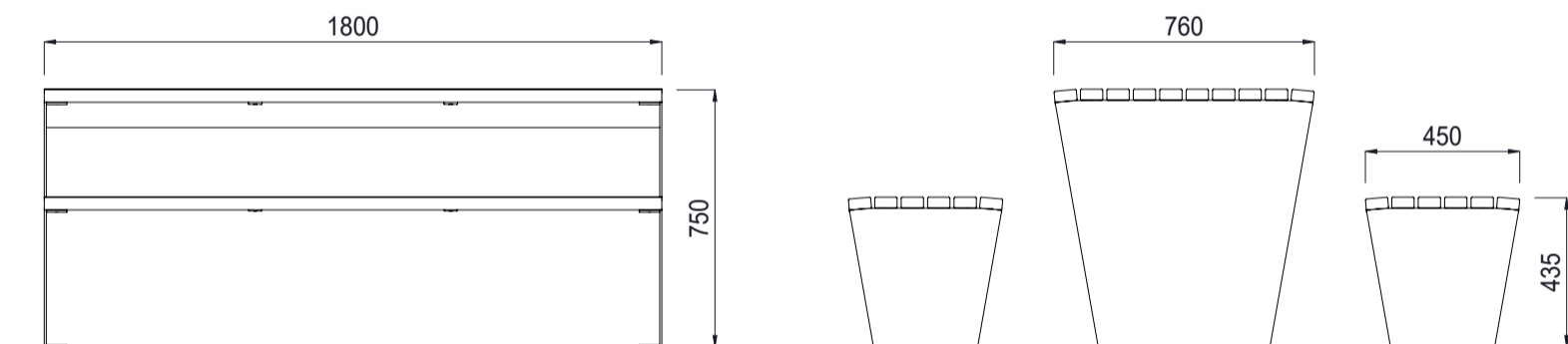

- Furniture is not supplied with installation instructions, install fastenings or footing details. These are to be specified and determined by the installing contractor for the specific requirements of each site.
- Corten steel develops a protective patina as it ages. Uncoated Corten risks staining substrates below in the early stages post installation. Placement of Corten objects and run off drainage should be carefully considered. Pre-weathering and sealing the Corten can help reduce surface staining significantly, or alternatively a faux Corten powder coat finish is an option when sealing is not an option.
